#### CALL TO ORDER

Janice Cook called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Bruce Rider, seconded by Lynda Brown, to approve the July 18th, 2016 meeting minutes as written:

#### Update on Oath of Office

Board appointees were sworn in after the last meeting. There was no formal action taken.

#### Update on Expansion of Teen Room and Genealogy

Janis Roberson informed the board members that the new exterior brick and mortar matches the existing building exterior materials well. Flashing on the windows is still to be delivered. The interior painting should begin soon. If everything stays on track, the new carpeting should arrive soon. Books will be moved the week of November 7<sup>th</sup>. The project is still within budget. There was no formal action taken.

#### Update on Budget for 2016-2017

Janis told the board that she submitted the 2016-2017 library budget as a “flat budget” in the operating budget. There was no formal action taken.

Discussion of Grand Opening of Expansion

March 4<sup>th</sup> is the library's 94<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Janis proposed that we use that date to celebrate all the moves within the library – Create It, Tween Zone, Genealogy, Teen Zone, etc. Tours of the entire library can be given. There was no formal action taken.

Discussion of Strategic Five Year Plan

Janis resubmitted the Mobile Library during the Capital & Quality of Life Section. She has sent the requirements and ideas to the bus company. They have sent back a rough draft, along with a blank copy, to play with on the design ideas. The bus would be 40' in length. After the confirmation of the order, the time to produce the bus is approximately twelve months. The estimated cost is \$390,000. The Bookmobile would travel 4-5 days with a two-week circulation. Members suggested some names to be painted on the bookmobile – "Alive in '95" and "Heard It on the Grapevine". There was no formal action taken.

Update on Friends' Artisan Marketplace

The Friends' annual Artisan Marketplace is scheduled for December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. Artisans will exhibit mostly handmade crafts and art. A percentage of the sales is donated to the Friends. There was no formal action taken.

The next quarterly board meeting is scheduled for January 16, 2017 at 6:30PM.


Bruce Rider, seconded by Fred Sheffler, motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:30PM. The motion prevailed by the following vote


